

CSAH 6 Reconstruction from Leyland Parkway (CSAH 16) to Fairgrounds Road (CSAH 44)

Updated 5/26/2017

Welcome

Faribault County will be reconstructing CSAH 6 from just north of Leyland Parkway to the Fairgrounds Road. This project includes replacing the bridge over the East Fork of the Blue Earth River, removing the concrete pavement, curbs, sidewalk and storm sewer. New concrete curbs, storm sewer and bituminous surfacing will be installed.

Project Background / Description

CSAH 6 is the Old Highway 169. The bridge over the river was constructed in 1936 and the concrete has deteriorated to the point that the bridge must be replaced. The original highway was designed for 4 lane traffic. Because 4 lanes are no longer needed, the bridge and highway will be reduced to 2 -12' lanes with 6' shoulders.

Schedule

- The bridge painting is complete.
- Final layer of bituminous and 6" pavement striping is scheduled for the middle of June 2017.

How Traffic is Affected

The bridge and North Main Street are now open.

Expect temporary daytime lane closures for bituminous paving.
